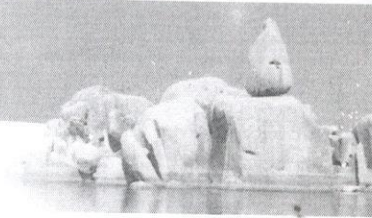

Reminders

Dear parents and carers,

As we come to the end of another busy and successful half term, we would like to thank you for your ongoing support. Below are some reminders about the procedures at IISM. Please familiarise yourself with these before we return on Monday 28th February.

Uniform

Please ensure you are familiar with the school's uniform policy; a copy is available on the school website. If your child is not in the correct uniform for a reason, please ensure that their class teacher/tutor is informed. Hoodies (including MSC hoodies), coats and other sweaters are not permitted in class as uniform even in cold weather. Students may wear these at break and lunch times only. We are looking to introduce a school Hoodie as an optional part of the official school uniform, more details to follow soon.

Mobile Phones policy in Secondary School

Sixth form are allowed their phones when not in lesson and can use them in your class at the discretion of the teacher. All other year groups are not to have phones out in lessons unless they have permission from the teacher to use them for academic purposes only.

If a student brings a mobile phone into school, then it is their responsibility to keep it safe. The school does not accept any liability for lost or damaged mobiles. Speakers are not to be used in classrooms or outside and headphones should not be worn in lessons.

End of the day

It is for your children's safety and security that we implement the following procedures for the end of the school day. All students must leave school promptly at the end of the school day and after clubs, particularly Key Stage 2 children who must be picked up at 2.15pm and leave the school gates. Students are not allowed to use the playground equipment as they are not supervised. We ask that parents waiting for secondary students, wait outside the school gates with their primary children. The school can not supervise your child after 2.15pm and they must not be playing on the play equipment. Children of school staff are allowed to wait in the library until they are taken home. They are not allowed to wait with their parents as they are still working.

For Secondary students, unless they are in a club or are working with a teacher then they should leave the school premises at 15:15. If they are waiting to be collected then they should wait at the steps at the front of the school. No students are permitted to play football or any other sport unless they are part of a club. Sixth Form may stay on for an hour to work if they so choose. No student should return to school once they have left the school grounds. If students persist in not following these rules, then we shall place them in a classroom and start charging for supervision.

By adhering to the above we shall go from strength to strength as a school as well as ensure that students are safe at all times.
